

Success stories for tough oil, gas and petrochemical applications

PLUNGER LIFT SYSTEMS

Superior performance in extreme conditions.

Challenge: Effective plunger control in remote locations requires miniature latching valves to consistently drive the opening and closing of pneumatic well shutoff valves. In extreme cold conditions, some latching valves 'stick' in open or closed positions, either unnecessarily shutting off production or allowing water contamination.

Solution: Gems' third-generation latching valves are designed to significantly improve performance in cold conditions, with proprietary magnetic plunger characteristics. Gems' vertically integrated manufacturing process allows customers to make a wide range of design modifications to adapt our valve to your precise conditions and needs.





'MUD' TANKS

Specialized, self-cleaning floats keep an eye on mud.

Challenge: Drilling mud is a highly viscous liquid that coats everything on contact and is very effective in maintaining hydrostatic pressure and temperature during drilling. If mud is allowed to dry on sensor shafts, accurate levels cannot be detected, as dried mud has a concrete-like consistency. This sensor-driven problem can force a time-consuming and expensive service call.

Solution: Gems designed a specialized, self-cleaning sensor that maintains consistent, accurate tracking as mud level rise and fall. Gems' mud sensors are manufactured with stainless steel, enhancing their durability. Accurate sensing and a rugged sensor keep the well running, and keep unscheduled downtime to a minimum.



CHEMICAL INJECTION SYSTEMS

Real-time, remote tracking lets you stay in control.

Challenge: More than 70% of producing wells worldwide require some kind of chemical injection. Replenishing these chemicals is often via a 20th Century solution based on timing calculations. If the calculation is off, unnecessary replenishments can occur, or worse, chemical tanks can run dry and not fill their function in production.

Solution: Gems' continuous level transmitter technology combined with wireless telemetry provides remote, real-time access to inventory levels. The low power requirements of Gems' sensors allow them to be run from a variety of power sources, including solar panels.





CNG/LNG STATIONS

Smarter, smaller systems to help control costs in rapid-growth sectors.

Challenge: CNG/LNG compressors, storage vessels and dispensers are at the heart of natural gas refueling systems for point of use and fleet service vehicles. Because CNG/LNG costs less to use and produces dramatically less CO₂ than traditional fuels, new refueling stations are being installed alongside of traditional gas/petrol stations at a rapidly growing pace. As stations expand, costs must be safely kept under control to stay competitive.

Solution: Gems' pressure transducers are built with reliable, sputtered thin film technology. The compact size makes it ideal for tight spaces so manufacturers can reduce the product footprint and corresponding costs. And our low-energy, continuous-transmittal technology adds a new level of safety as CNG/LNG refueling stations become accessible to a broader audience.
